The Minnesota PGA Junior Golf 'Sota Series would like to have a minimum of ONE (1) On-Site Administrator at each event. Ideal candidates will be located in various cities throughout the Minnesota PGA Section.

AVAILABLE: The Minnesota PGA Junior Golf 'Sota Series season begins June 9 and

runs through mid-August. (Specific dates for each administrator will be assigned in mid-April. On-site administrator will have the ability to

choose which events they are scheduled to work)

REQUIREMENTS: Knowledge of running a golf tournament and the Rules of Golf.

Ability to work with others to manage up to 120 juniors on the golf

course.

Must be reliable, willing to travel various distances, and have

dependable transportation.

Commit to AT LEAST EIGHT (8) events throughout the summer.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Conduct the event from start to finish, which includes:

Golf Course set up and preparation, participant registration, conduct rules meeting prior to tee off, starting event, rules official throughout the round, monitoring pace of play, posting scores, presenting awards,

communicating with Junior Golf Staff via email/text
